These service providers are contractually bound to our privacy principles and are not authorised by us to use or disclose the information except as necessary to perform services or functions for Optimus Cards or to comply with legal requirements. We may also disclose information about you if we are required to do so by law <u>or</u> in response to a request from law enforcement authorities.
